#### Broker Assisted Electronic Enrollment Application Program Guidelines:

- o Submitted business is defined as an enrollment application submitted with the intent of clients obtaining a Bright Health MAPD plan based on their healthcare needs
- The allowance is an administrative fee paid to Brokers who are contracted with Bright Health for the 2020 plan year and have met the certification requirements. Using Bright Health's Medicare Enrollment Dashboard provides a streamlined and efficient enrollment process and enhances the Brokers' ability to be consultative in determining a suitable Bright Health MAPD plan for clients. To qualify for the administrative allowance, the client must select an in-network primary care physician with valid NPI and complete the entire electronic enrollment process through Bright Health's electronic enrollment platform for an effective date during the 2020 plan year.

Administrative allowance payments will be made for assistance with online applications the month following the policy effective date. The administrative allowance is payable for broker time, expertise, and and familiarity with the Medicare Enrollment Dashboard. Administrative allowance is not paid for or dependent on enrollment and is distinctly separate from the sales commission and associated CMS commission guidelines.
